



# 2012-13 GRIZ HOOPS



Montana Hosts San Diego Toreros  
Saturday, Nov. 24 in non-league contest

**THE GAMES:** The University of Montana Grizzlies (2-1) are back home this Saturday, hosting the San Diego Toreros (3-3) on Nov. 24, in UM's Dahlberg Arena (7,321), with **tip-off at 6:00 p.m.** Next week the Griz are on the road for two games, playing the **BYU Cougars** on Wednesday, Nov. 28, and the **San Francisco Dons** on Friday, Nov. 30th.

**GRIZ LAST TWO GAMES: Montana 66, at Idaho 63:** Junior forward **Spencer Coleman** made a big 3-pointer to put the Griz ahead 59-57 with 4:12 to go, and senior forward **Mathias Ward** made three lay-ups and a free throw in the final few minutes of the game. Junior guard-forward **Kareem Jamar** led Montana in scoring with 17 points, while Ward had 16. The Grizzlies shot 53.8% (14-of-26) from the field in the second half. Montana out-rebounded Idaho 34-31 (which was the first time in three games). UI led 34-30 at halftime.

**At Montana 82, Minot State 53:** The Grizzlies scored 29 points off of turnovers and had four players score in double figures in the win. **Ward** led the Griz with 19 points, while **Jamar** scored 18. Also in double figures for UM were sophomore forward **Mike Weisner** who tallied a career-high 11 points, and **Coleman** added 10 points in his first career start.

**THREE TOP SCORERS BACK: Cherry and Jamar** were first team all-league selections last season and **Cherry** led the Griz in scoring (15.8 ppg). **Jamar** was UM's second leading scorer (10.9 ppg), while **Ward** was third (10.9 ppg).

**GRIZ LAST SEASON:** The Griz, ranked 14th in the *collegeinsider.com*'s Mid-Major poll, beat Weber State 85-66 to win the Big Sky's post-season tournament title and advance to the NCAA tournament (a 73-49 loss to Wisconsin).

**TINKLE FOURTH ON WINS LIST:** Seventh-year Montana head coach **Wayne Tinkle** has 118 career wins -- the fourth most in school history.

**SERIES/LAST MEETING:** The series is tied 3-3. The teams played last season, and were led by **Jamar** (14 points) and **Cherry** (13 points) in a 73-60 win at USD. The Toreros, who return all five starters from last season, were led by 6-9 forward **Chris Manresa**, who had 19 points and 11 rebounds a year ago against the Grizzlies. **Manresa** has one start this season, but has missed the past few games due to a back injury.

## MONTANA HEAD COACH WAYNE TINKLE (118-72, Seventh Season at Montana)

Wayne Tinkle is now in his seventh season as the head coach at The University of Montana in 2012-13. He has an overall record of 118-72 (.621). His 118 career victories are the fourth most in school history.

In 2011-12 he guided Montana to its second trip to the “Big Dance” in his tenure, as the 13<sup>th</sup>-seeded Grizzlies played the fourth-seeded and 14<sup>th</sup>-ranked (*Associated Press*) Wisconsin Badgers in a second round NCAA Tournament game in Albuquerque, N.M.

Tinkle’s Griz teams have now won 20 or more games the past three years in a row, going 22-10, 21-11, and 25-7 last season. He is 66-30 (.688) in Big Sky games.

With its NCAA berth in 2012, Montana and Coach Tinkle have now advanced to post-season play a school-record three straight seasons. He is one of just three coaches in school history to win 20 or more games in three straight seasons.

Montana’s 25 victories in the 2011-12 season are the third most in school history. He was recognized for the Grizzlies’ success in 2012, as he was named the NABC Division I All-District 6 “Coach of the Year” by The National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). He was also tabbed the Big Sky’s “Coach of the Year.” He’s the fifth coach ever at Montana (since 1963) to be named the Big Sky’s coach of the year.

Two seasons ago Tinkle guided Montana to a 21-11 record and a berth in the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) Tournament. Three seasons ago, the Griz went 22-10, won the league’s post-season tourney, and advanced to the NAAs, losing 62-57 to New Mexico.

Coach Tinkle has now been to the NCAA tournament a total of five times – two as the head man and three times as an assistant coach at Montana. His NCAA trips were in 2009-10 and 2011-12 as the head man against New Mexico and Wisconsin, respectively. He was also a member of three other UM NCAA tournament teams: 2001-02 against Oregon with head coach Don Holst; in 2004-05 vs. Washington; and in 2005-06 season (against Nevada and Boston College) with head man Larry Krystkowiak.

Tinkle, 46, was named the 26th head men’s basketball coach at Montana in the summer of 2006. He served as an assistant coach at UM for the previous five seasons, working with Krystkowiak for two seasons, two years with Pat Kennedy (2002-04), and one with Holst.

He was a standout forward for the Griz from 1985-89 and a three-time All-Big Sky pick his sophomore, junior and senior seasons. He is ranked fourth in UM history in career rebounds with 836 and sixth in career points with 1,500.

He was Montana’s *Carl Dragstedt Award* (MVP) winner in 1988 and 1989. He led the team in rebounding in 1987 (8.9 average), 1988 (8.4 average), and 1989 (8.7 avg.), and in scoring in 1988 (16.2 ppg) and 1989 (17.1 ppg).

He played in the pro ranks for 12 seasons (1990 to 2001). In his professional career he played in the CBA, as well as in Sweden, Spain, Italy and Greece. He played his final four seasons in Spain from 1995-99, where he ranked among the league’s top scorers and rebounders.

Wayne was born in Milwaukee, Wis., and is the youngest of 11 children (seven girls and four boys). He is a 1984 graduate of Ferris High School in Spokane, Wash. He received his degree in health and human performance from UM in 2005.

He is married to former Lady Griz basketball star Lisa McLeod, who was inducted into the Grizzly Sports Hall of Fame in the fall of 2011. Wayne and Lisa have three children: daughters Joslyn and Elleson, and son Tres. Joslyn is a senior starter at Stanford, while Elle is now playing hoops at Gonzaga.

### MORE GRIZ NOTES FROM LAST SEASON

**FOUR PLAYERS NAMED ALL-LEAGUE:** For the first time in school history (since 1963-64), four Griz players were named to the All-Big Sky team. **Cherry** and **Jamar** were named to the first team, and senior forwards **Derek Selvig** and **Art Steward** were second team picks.

**CHERRY ALL-TIME LEADER IN STEALS:** **Cherry's** 223 career steals are the most ever at Montana and the fifth most in league history.

**HONORS ROLL IN FOR CHERRY:** Last season **Cherry**, from West Oakland, Calif., was one of 25 players named to the 2012 Lou Henson Mid-Major All-America team. He was selected to the 10-player All-District VIII basketball team by the USBWA. **Cherry** was also voted as the Big Sky's "Defensive Player of the Year."

**THREE 20-WIN SEASONS IN A ROW:** Montana has won 20 or more games three consecutive seasons, going 25-7 last year, 22-10 in 2009-10, and 21-10 three seasons ago.

**TINKLE FOURTH IN WINS:** **Head Coach Wayne Tinkle** begins his seventh season at his alma mater ranked fourth in school history with 116 career victories.

**GRIZ AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS:** Montana was ranked in the top 50 in the nation (338 teams ranked) in **five categories in 2011-12:** win-lost percentage (24th, 78.1%), field goal percentage defense (40th, 40.5%), turnover margin (42nd, +2.4), scoring margin (44th, +7.9 ppg), and scoring defense (49th, 62.0 ppg).

### **Coach Wayne Tinkle Quotes:**

**ON SAN DIEGO:** "It's nice that we've got the week (between games) to improve in some areas that we need to, and we're also getting a little healthy.

"San Diego had a lot of young guys on their team last year, and we were able to get them down there. They ended up having a pretty decent season considering they were so young a year ago. They return all five starters from that team. This year they are off to a good start. I know their win-loss record doesn't show it, but they've played a lot of games recently in a tournament, and they are looking to come up here and seek a little revenge.

**ON GRIZ:** "We feel pretty good. We just finished watching the Idaho tape. We did not play well offensively or defensively, but our guys showed a lot of grit and a lot of toughness to come back on the road early in the season with a young team and pull that one out after being down 15 points (50-35 with 12:27 left to play) in the second half.

**ABOUT USING A SMALL LINE-UP:** "It is a little different than what we are used to, but we knew that going into the season that we would have a small line-up some of the time. It's kind of fun for our staff. We've got to work with what we have and change things up, and I am proud that the guys have reacted the way that they have and that they have had some success out there.

"Rebounding was a concern with our small line-up when we went on the road, but we out-rebounded Idaho, so that's a good start. We feel that this is a versatile team, and we can mix-and-match and change our line-ups. If the guys continue to perform I think it could work very successfully for us.

**ON THE GRIZ:** "Kareem and Mathias are playing really well, which is what we would expect from two returning starters. We need their consistency and leadership.

"Spencer (Coleman) is starting to get it. He's still not quite 100 percent and I know that bothers him. He hit some big threes for us at Idaho and rebounded the ball well.

"Kevin Henderson is giving us a ton of energy on the defensive end.

"Both Keron and Jordan Gregory have stepped up. When one of them wasn't quite playing his best, the other one was. They've given us a nice combination there.

"I like the minutes that (true freshmen) Jake (Wiley) and Andrew (Martin) are getting. They are doing some good, positive things, and getting better every day. We know this (the team) is a work in progress, and it's nice to see us improve from week-to-week."
